An Act criminalizing the possession of ingredients for manufactured drugs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 94C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following section:-
- 3 Section 32L
- 4 Section 1. (a) Any person who possesses at the same time any of the following combinations, a
- 5 combination product thereof, or possesses any compound or mixture containing the chemicals
- 6 listed in the following combinations, with the intent to
- 7 manufacture phencyclidine (PCP) or any of its analogs is guilty of a felony and shall be punished
- 8 by imprisonment in the state prison for 5 years:

- 9 (1) Piperidine and cyclohexanone.
- 10 (2) Pyrrolidine and cyclohexanone.
- 11 (3) Morpholine and cyclohexanone.
- 12 (b) Any person who possesses the optical, positional, or geometric isomer of any of the
- 13 compounds listed in this section, with the intent to manufacture these controlled substances is
- 14 guilty of a felony and shall be punished by imprisonment in the
- 15 state prison for 5 years:
- 16 (1) Phencyclidine (PCP).
- 17 (2) Any analog of PCP
- 18 (c) Any person who possesses any compound or mixture containing piperidine, cyclohexanone,
- 19 pyrrolidine, morpholine, 1-phenylcyclohexylamine (PCA),
- 20 1-piperidinocyclohexanecarbonitrile (PCC), or phenylmagnesium bromide (PMB) with the intent
- 21 to manufacture phencyclidine, is guilty of a felony and shall be punished by imprisonment in the
- 22 state prison for 5 years.
- 23 (d) Any person who possesses immediate precursors sufficient for the manufacture of piperidine,
- 24 cyclohexanone, pyrrolidine, morpholine, or phenylmagnesium bromide (PMB) with the intent to
- 25 manufacture phencyclidine, is guilty of a felony and shall be
- 26 punished by imprisonment in the state prison for 5 years.

- 27 (e) This section does not apply to drug manufacturers licensed by this state or persons authorized
- 28 by regulation of the board of registration in pharmacy to possess those substances or
- 29 combinations of substances.
- 30 SECTION 2. (a) Any person who possesses both methylamine and phenyl-2-propanone
- 31 (phenylacetone) at the same time with the intent to manufacture methamphetamine, or who
- 32 possesses both ethylamine and phenyl-2-propanone (phenylacetone) at the
- 33 same time with the intent to manufacture N-ethylamphetamine, is guilty of a felony and shall be
- 34 punished by imprisonment in the state prison for 5 years.
- 35 (b) (1) Any person who, with the intent to manufacture methamphetamine or any of its analogs,
- 36 possesses ephedrine or pseudoephedrine, or any salts, isomers, or salts of isomers of ephedrine or
- 37 pseudoephedrine, or who possesses a substance containing
- 38 ephedrine or pseudoephedrine, or any salts, isomers, or salts of isomers of ephedrine or
- 39 pseudoephedrine, or who possesses at the same time any of the following, or a combination
- 40 product thereof, is guilty of a felony and shall be punished by
- 41 imprisonment in the state prison for 5 years:
- 42 (A) Ephedrine, pseudoephedrine, norpseudoephedrine,
- 43 N-methylephedrine, N-ethylephedrine,
- 44 N-methylpseudoephedrine, N-ethylpseudoephedrine, or
- 45 phenylpropanolamine, plus hydriodic acid.
- 46 (B) Ephedrine, pseudoephedrine, norpseudoephedrine,

- 47 N-methylephedrine, N-ethylephedrine,
- 48 N-methylpseudoephedrine, N-ethylpseudoephedrine, or
- 49 phenylpropanolamine, thionyl chloride and hydrogen gas.
- 50 (C) Ephedrine, pseudoephedrine, norpseudoephedrine,
- 51 N-methylephedrine, N-ethylephedrine,
- 52 N-methylpseudoephedrine, N-ethylpseudoephedrine, or
- 53 phenylpropanolamine, plus phosphorus pentachloride and
- 54 hydrogen gas.
- 55 (D) Ephedrine, pseudoephedrine, norpseudoephedrine,
- 56 N-methylephedrine, N-ethylephedrine,
- 57 N-methylpseudoephedrine, N-ethylpseudoephedrine,
- 58 chloroephedrine and chloropseudoephedrine, or
- 59 phenylpropanolamine, plus any reducing agent
- 60 (2) Any person who, with the intent to manufacture methamphetamine or any of its analogs,
- 61 possesses hydriodic acid or a reducing agent or any product containing hydriodic acid or a
- 62 reducing agent is guilty of a felony and shall be punished by imprisonment
- 63 in the state prison for 5 years.

- 64 (c) Any person who possesses the optical, positional, or geometric isomer of any of the
- 65 compounds listed in this section, with the intent to manufacture any of the following controlled
- substances, is guilty of a felony and shall be punished by imprisonment in the state prison for 5
- 67 years:
- 68 (1) Methamphetamine.
- 69 (2) Any analog of methamphetamine
- 70 (3) N-ethylamphetamine.
- 71 (d) Any person who possesses immediate precursors sufficient for the manufacture of
- methylamine, ethylamine, phenyl-2-propanone, ephedrine, pseudoephedrine,
- 73 norpseudoephedrine, N-methylephedrine, N-ethylephedrine, phenylpropanolamine, hydriodic
- 74 acid or a reducing agent, thionyl chloride, or phosphorus pentachloride, with the intent to
- 75 manufacture methamphetamine, is guilty of a felony and shall be
- 76 punished by imprisonment in the state prison for 5 years.
- 77 (e) Any person who possesses essential chemicals sufficient to manufacture hydriodic acid or a
- 78 reducing agent, with the intent to manufacture methamphetamine, is guilty of a felony and shall
- 79 be punished by imprisonment in the state prison for 5 years.
- 80 (f) Any person who possesses any compound or mixture containing ephedrine, pseudoephedrine,
- 81 norpseudoephedrine, N-methylephedrine, N-ethylephedrine, phenylpropanolamine, hydriodic
- 82 acid or a reducing agent, thionyl chloride, or

- 83 phosphorus pentachloride, with the intent to manufacture methamphetamine, is guilty of a felony
- 84 and shall be punished by imprisonment in the state prison for 5 years.
- 85 (g) For purposes of this section, a "reducing agent" for the purposes of manufacturing
- 86 methamphetamine means an agent that causes reduction to occur by either donating a hydrogen
- 87 atom to an organic compound or by removing an oxygen atom
- 88 from an organic compound.
- 89 (h) This section does not apply to drug manufacturers licensed by this state or persons authorized
- 90 by regulation of the board of registration in pharmacy to possess those substances or
- 91 combinations of substances.
- 92 SECTION 3. (a) Any person who possesses at the same time any of the following combinations,
- 93 a combination product thereof, or possesses any compound or mixture containing the chemicals
- 94 listed in the following combinations, with the intent to sell, transfer, or otherwise furnish those
- 95 chemicals, combinations, or mixtures to another person with the knowledge that they will be
- 96 used to manufacture phencyclidine (PCP) or any of its analogs is guilty of a misdemeanor and
- 97 shall be punished by imprisonment in the house of correction for up to 2 and ½ years:
- 98 (1) Piperidine and cyclohexanone.
- 99 (2) Pyrrolidine and cyclohexanone.
- 100 (3) Morpholine and cyclohexanone.
- 101 (b) Any person who possesses the optical, positional, or geometric isomer of any of the
- 102 compounds listed in this section with the intent to sell, transfer, or otherwise furnish the isomer
- 103 to another person with the knowledge that they will be used to manufacture these controlled

- substances is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by imprisonment in the house of
- 105 correction for up to 2 and ½ years:
- 106 (1) Phencyclidine (PCP).
- 107 (2) Any analog of PCP
- 108 (c) Any person who possesses any compound or mixture containing piperidine, cyclohexanone,
- 109 pyrrolidine, morpholine, 1-phenylcyclohexylamine (PCA),
- 110 1-piperidinocyclohexanecarbonitrile (PCC), or phenylmagnesium bromide (PMB) with the intent
- 111 to sell, transfer, or otherwise furnish the compound or mixture to another person with the
- knowledge that it will be used to manufacture phencyclidine is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall
- be punished by imprisonment in the house of correction for up to 2 and 1/2 years.
- 114 (d) Any person who possesses immediate precursors sufficient for the manufacture of piperidine,
- 115 cyclohexanone, pyrrolidine, morpholine, or phenylmagnesium bromide (PMB) with the intent to
- 116 sell, transfer or otherwise furnish the immediate precursors to
- another person with the knowledge that they will be used to manufacture phencyclidine is guilty
- of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by imprisonment in the house of correction for up to 2
- 119 and 1/2 years.
- 120 (e) This section does not apply to drug manufacturers licensed by this state or persons authorized
- 121 by regulation of the board of registration in pharmacy to possess those substances or
- 122 combinations of substances.

- SECTION 4. (a) Any person who possesses both methylamine and phenyl-2-propanone
- 124 (phenylacetone) at the same time with the intent to sell, transfer, or otherwise furnish those
- 125 chemicals to another person with the knowledge that they will be used to
- 126 manufacture methamphetamine, or who possesses both ethylamine and phenyl-2-propanone
- 127 (phenylacetone) at the same time with the intent to sell, transfer, or otherwise furnish those
- 128 chemicals to another person with the knowledge that they will be used to manufacture
- 129 methamphetamine is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by imprisonment in the
- 130 house of correction for up to 2 and 1/2 years.
- (b) (1) Any person who possesses ephedrine or pseudoephedrine, or any salts, isomers, or salts of
- 132 isomers of ephedrine or pseudoephedrine, or who possesses a substance containing ephedrine or
- 133 pseudoephedrine, or any salts, isomers, or salts of isomers of ephedrine or pseudoephedrine, or
- 134 who possesses at the same time any of the following, or a combination product thereof, with the
- intent to sell, transfer, or otherwise furnish those chemicals, substances, or products to another
- 136 person with the knowledge that they will be used to manufacture methamphetamine or any of its
- 137 analogs is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by imprisonment in the house of
- 138 correction for up to 2 and $\frac{1}{2}$ years:
- 139 (A) Ephedrine, pseudoephedrine, norpseudoephedrine,
- 140 N-methylephedrine, N-ethylephedrine,

- 157 (2) Any person who possesses hydriodic acid or a reducing agent or any product containing
- 158 hydriodic acid or a reducing agent with the intent to sell, transfer, or otherwise furnish that
- 159 chemical, product, or substance to another person with the knowledge that they will be used to
- 160 manufacture methamphetamine or any of its analogs is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be
- 161 punished by imprisonment in the house of correction for up to 2 and ½ years.

- 162 (c) Any person who possesses the optical, positional, or geometric isomer of any of the
 163 compounds listed in this section with the intent to sell, transfer, or otherwise furnish any of the
 164 compounds to another person with the knowledge that they will be used to manufacture these
 165 controlled substances is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by imprisonment in the
 166 house of correction for up to 2 and ½ years:
- 167 (1) Methamphetamine.
- 168 (2) Any analog of methamphetamine
- 169 (3) N-ethylamphetamine.
- 170 (d) Any person who possesses immediate precursors sufficient for the manufacture of

- 172 norpseudoephedrine, N-methylephedrine, N-ethylephedrine, phenylpropanolamine, hydriodic

- 187 mixture to another person with the knowledge that they will be used to manufacture
