**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to the sales tax.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 8 of Chapter 64H of the General
2 Laws or any general or special law or regulation to the contrary, including 830 CMR
3 64H,25,1(7), the purchase of a motor vehicle, trailer, or other vehicle by a rental company as so
4 defined in section 32E ½ of chapter 175 of the general laws shall not be considered an exempt
5 use from the sales tax at retail.
