An Act relative to the electronic deposit of tax refunds.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 85 of chapter 62C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the second sentence the following  
3 sentence:-

4           For refunds processed electronically and paid through direct deposit, the commissioner  
5 shall permit a taxpayer to elect to have his or her refund split and deposited into more than one  
6 bank account, including, but not limited to higher education savings plans or accounts.
