An Act relative to clarifying the reporting of record keeping requirements.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 52C of Chapter 149, as recently amended by section 148 of chapter 240 of
- 2 the acts of 2010, is amended at the end of the second paragraph by inserting the following
- 3 sentence:- “The term ‘negatively affect’ shall mean the use of the information in question
- 4 constitutes the sole basis for determining an employee’s qualification.”
