An Act relative to retroactive capital reimbursement for a certain nursing facility.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to provide retroactive reimbursement to a certain nursing facility , therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, for the  
2 nursing home licensed in accordance with Section 71 of Chapter 111 of the General Laws and  
3 which is located within the Town of Holden, and which provides services to high acuity  
4 individuals, individuals in need of ventilator treatment, and individuals in need of skilled nursing  
5 care, shall receive its requested revised capital payment filed in 2014, retroactive to July 22,  
6 2013, inclusive. The executive office of health and human services, the office of medicaid and  
7 the Center for Health Information and Analysis and any other agency of the commonwealth

- 8 having jurisdiction, shall approve an effective date of July 22, 2013 for the requested revised
- 9 capital payment.
