Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: Chapter 31 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby amended by inserting

2 after last paragraph the following:-

3 "All employees employed by the Commonwealth and by cities, towns, and districts, in the

4 Commonwealth in a provisional official service position for two years or more shall be made

5 permanent employees. The Personnel Administration shall annually report to the General Court

6 the number of provisional official service employees made permanent."
