An Act to restore local control in coastal communities of the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 21 F of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:
- 2 Section 8: Any coastal city or town acting through its mayor with the approval of the city
- 3 council, through its manager and town council in a town having town council form of
- 4 government, or through its board of selectmen and town meeting in any other town may
- 5 designate a proposed area of coastal waters adjacent to said city or town or a land area within the
- 6 boundaries of said city or town as a “wind development exclusion zone.”
