An Act authorizing Edward Grace to take the civil service examination.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Whereas, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which
- 2 is to forthwith to allow Edward Grace to take the police and firefighters examinations, therefore
- 3 it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the
- 4 public convenience.
- 5 Notwithstanding chapter 31 of the General Laws or any other general or special law, rule or
- 6 regulation to the contrary regulating the maximum age of applicants for appointment Edward
- 7 Grace of the city of Boston shall be eligible to take the next open competitive examinations for
