*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 6 of Chapter 62 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out clause (5) of subsection (k) and inserting in  
3 place thereof the following new clause:-  
4 (5) the department of revenue shall establish a mechanism by which a married individual not  
5 filing jointly shall be allowed a credit under this subsection.  
6 SECTION 2. The department of revenue shall adopt the mechanism not later than 90 days after  
7 the effective date of this Act.
