**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court

An Act entitling residents west of 128 to discounted access to the Massachusetts Turnpike.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Massachusetts  
2 Department of Transportation is hereby directed to develop and institute a program providing  
3 discounted toll rates to residents who reside in communities that host any part of the  
4 Massachusetts Turnpike west of Route 128, and who participate in the E-ZPass MA program set  
5 forth by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, when they use the Massachusetts Turnpike. Such  
6 a discount shall be set at a rate which is not less than a ten percent discount off the maximum  
7 percentage toll provided by the Massachusetts Department of Transportation to the residents of  
8 any other community in the Commonwealth.
