## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act Updating Non-Taxable Medical Supplies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Paragraph (1) of Section

2 6 of Chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby

3 amended by adding, in line 12, after the word "lifts," the following words:

4 "infusion pumps used to deliver drugs to patients who require intravenous fluids, antibiotics,

5 chemotherapy, pain management, blood products, biotechnology agents and any other

6 intravenous infusions ordered by a physician and related disposables including administration

7 sets, extension sets, filters, needle-less connectors, sterile covers, syringes/needles, alcohol

8 wipes, gloves, tape, and sharps containers; central venous catheters, peripherally inserted central

9 catheters, ports or peripheral intravenous catheters, central venous dressing kits, venous access

10 device kits, Huber needles, and securing devices; continuous positive airway pressure (CPAP)

11 and Bi-level positive airway pressure (BIPAP) supplies, including tubing, headgear, nasal masks,

12 full masks, and filters; suction machines used in the care of a patient's tracheostomy, including

suction canisters, suction connecting tubing, suction catheters, trach care kits, peroxide, sterile
sponges, sterile q-tips, and gloves; and other durable medical equipment, including bathroom
commodes, nebulizers, and aerosol-generating devices."
