**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to making Election Day a state holiday.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 7 of chapter 4 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “October”, in line 92, the
3 following words:- “the day in November in any year in which presidential electors are to be
4 elected.”
