Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 23B of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-
- 2 Section 31. For the purposes of calculating an applicant's income for any publically
- 3 assisted housing, the department shall not include a veteran's disability benefit paid pursuant to
- 4 38 U.S.C. section 1101 et seq.
