An Act relative to retired police cruisers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 92 of chapter 148 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition in hereby amended by striking out the words, in lines 12 and 13 "shall be
- 3 punished by a fine of not less than ten nor more than five hundred dollars" and inserting in place
- 4 thereof the following:-
- 5 "shall be punished by a fine of not less than one thousand nor more than twenty-five
- 6 hundred dollars."
