In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)

An Act relative to motorist safety from commercial vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 90 of the general laws shall be amended by adding after section
2 14B, the following new section:

3 Section 14C. No commercial motor vehicle shall be operated on public roads and no
4 owner of such vehicle shall allow operation of such vehicle on a public road with an
5 accumulation of snow or ice on the roof of such vehicle if the accumulation of such snow or ice
6 or combination of snow and ice is one quarter of an inch thick or greater. It shall be the
7 responsibility of the owner as well as the operator of such vehicle to ensure the removal of
8 accumulated snow and ice from a vehicle before the vehicle is operated on any public road.

9 Commercial vehicle operators who violate any provision of this section shall be punished
10 by a fine of not less than five hundred dollars for each offense which does not cause personal
11 injury or property damage and ten thousand dollars for offenses resulting in personal injury or
12 property damage.
