## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to informational technology upgrade reimbursements for next-generation MCAS compliance.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the state

- 2 treasurer shall annually, on or before November twentieth, reimburse any city, town, regional
- 3 school district or independent vocational school for expenditures incurred during the previous
- 4 fiscal year for upgrading informational technology hardware, software and training necessary for
- 5 compliance with the next-generation Massachusetts Comprehensive Assessment System.
