An Act relating to public access to historical records.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 7 of Chapter 66 of the General Laws, is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting at the end thereto the following sentence: All records in the custody of the state
- 3 secretary shall be open to public inspection and available for copying after the expiration of
- 4 seventy-five years from creation of the record.
