The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act limiting the use of prison labor.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 127 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-
- 2 "Section 170. Labor Within the Commonwealth.
- No inmate or prisoner of any facility governed by this title shall labor outside the
- 4 boundaries of the Commonwealth.".
