## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act to Encourage Economic Competition.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, no authority, as defined by
- 2 section 39 of chapter 3, shall require a project labor agreement of any proposed construction
- 3 contract advertised by said authority.
