## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**  
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An Act relative to affiliate transfers..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 193P of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new paragraph: -

3 Nothing in this section shall be construed to require notice if an insurer within the same group of  
4 insurers issues or offers to issue a succeeding policy to the insured.

5 SECTION 2. Section 113F of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official  
6 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line 47 after the word “company.” the following new  
7 paragraph: -

- 8 Nothing in this section shall be construed to require notice if an insurer within the same group of
- 9 insurers issues or offers to issue a succeeding policy to the insured.
