The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to littering.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
- 2 Section 22G the following section:-
- 3 "Section 22G 1/2. No operator of a motor vehicle shall litter, or knowingly permit an
- 4 occupant of their vehicle to litter on public or private property through the disposal of trash or
- 5 garbage from said motor vehicle. A violation of this section shall be considered a civil motor
- 6 vehicle infraction and shall be punishable by a civil citation issued pursuant to chapter 90C,
- 7 which shall include a fine of \$100 for a first offense, \$250 for a second offense, and \$500 for a
- 8 third or subsequent offense. A civil citation issued pursuant to this section shall be considered a
- 9 surchargeable offense under section 113B of chapter 175."
- SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
