In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to school bus video monitoring systems.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1.	Chapter 90 of the	General Laws,	as appearing in the	e 2016 Official Edition,

2 is hereby amended by inserting after section 7B, the following new section:—

3 Section 7B  $\frac{1}{2}$ . (a) School districts may install and operate live digital video school bus

4 violation detection monitoring systems for the purposes of detecting violations of section 14 of

5 this chapter. All systems installed for use under this section must, at a minimum, produce a live

6 visual image viewable remotely, a recorded image of the license plate, and be able to record the

7 time, date, and location of the vehicle.

- 8 (b) School districts may enter into agreements with private corporations or other entities 9 to provide live digital video school bus violation detection monitoring systems and to maintain 10 and operate such systems.
- (c) All vehicles installed with a live digital video school bus violation detection
  monitoring system shall post a warning sign indicating the use of such system.
