An Act relative to implementing the Massachusetts yellow dot program.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6C of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the  
2 following section:-

3 Section 77. The secretary of transportation shall promulgate rules and regulations to  
4 implement and promote a program designed to alert first responders to an automobile accident  
5 that a person in the vehicle involved in the accident has pertinent medical information within the  
6 vehicle, known as the “Yellow Dot” program.
