In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to safe driving.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 9 of Chapter 155 of the Acts of 2010 is hereby amended by striking
- 2 the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following:-
- 3 ",Section 13B. (a) No operator of a motor vehicle shall use a mobile telephone, as defined

4 in Section 3, while operating a motor vehicle."
