*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. The City of Boston, Bridge Inspection Unit, shall perform a safety inspection of the
- 2 Long Island Bridge within the City of Boston, connecting Moon Island and Long Island.
- 3 SECTION 2. If the bridge is deemed unsafe, the The City of Boston, is instructed to implement
- 4 an alternate, economically feasible, means for transportation via water shuttle/barge access to
- 5 Long Island within 90 days of inspection.
