### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to pup trailers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 19 of Chapter 90 is hereby amended by inserting after "ten 2 thousand pounds" the following: or a trailer having at least two axles, which, when towed by a 3 motor vehicle operating with a general registration and general registration number plate issued 4 to a farmer pursuant to section 5, and when operating with a permit for exceeding weight 5 limitations pursuant to Chapter 85, Section 30A and when used solely for purposes of 6 transportation of agricultural goods and products on the roads and highways to an agricultural 7 processing facility under the control of an individual or entity engaged in farming and agriculture 8 as defined in Chapter 128 Section 1A located in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts with its 9 load weighs not more than ninety-nine thousand pounds as a combination of motor vehicle and 10 trailer.
