An Act requiring an actuarial study of the MBTA retirement fund.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The Secretary of Administration and Finance is directed to study the operation and performance
- 2 of the MBTA Retirement Fund, using actuarial methods, comparing the performance of the
- 3 MBTA Retirement Fund to other American retirement and pension funds, making note of such
- 4 other oversight issues as may arise during the study. The study is to be completed and submitted
- 5 to the Speaker of the House and the Senate President; the House and Senate Committees on
- 6 Ways and Means; the MBTA Board of Directors and the MBTA Advisory Board on or before
- 7 January 1, 2012.
