In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act to authorize firefighter motorcycle license plates.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 90 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after Section 6C the following:-
- 3 Section 6D: The registrar, upon payment of the fee required in Section thirty-three, shall
- 4 furnish to members of any municipal fire department, or members retired in good standing, a
- 5 special distinctive firefighter motorcycle license plate for use on private motorcycles owned and
- 6 operated by such firefighter. No such firefighter motorcycle license plate shall be issued or
- 7 renewed until proper certification has been made to the registrar by the head of the fire
- 8 department that the applicant is or was a member of the fire department.

- 9 In addition to the fee required in Section thirty-three, there shall be an additional fee of
- 10 ten dollars for the issuance and renewal of such firefighter motorcycle license plate to be
- 11 collected by the registrar and paid to the Massachusetts Firefighters Academy Trust Fund
- 12 pursuant to Section 165A of Chapter 6 of the General Laws.
