An Act relative to the law of the road and bicyclists.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 9 of chapter 89 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the sixth paragraph and inserting in place
- 3 thereof the following:-
- 4 For the purposes of this section the word, “vehicle”, shall include:
- 5 1) a motor vehicle as defined in Chapter 90, §1;
- 6 2) a trackless trolley; and
- 7 2) a bicycle regulated under Chapter 85 §11B.
