An Act relative to inspections for new automobiles..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION \_\_. Section 7A of Chapter 90, of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006  
2 official edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the fifth paragraph the following  
3 paragraph:-

4 “The emissions and maintenance inspection programs provided for in this article shall not  
5 apply to any in the year of its manufacture, nor the year succeeding its manufacture year. The  
6 commissioner shall promulgate such regulations as may be required to implement this  
7 exemption.”
