**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act requiring the hands-free use of mobile telephones while driving.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 13 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the word “mobile telephone” in line 6, and
3 inserting in place thereof the following:- hands-free mobile telephone.

4 SECTION 2. Section 13B of said chapter 90, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
5 inserting the following subsection:-

6 (a¹/₂) No operator of a motor vehicle shall use a mobile telephone or mobile electronic
7 device, unless the telephone or device is being used as a hands-free mobile telephone.
