An Act establishing gender neutral bathrooms.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 142 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
2 Section 13 the following section:-

3 Section 13a. The examiners shall promulgate regulations to allow gender neutral
4 bathrooms to be designed and installed in any use group defined by the 780 CMR Massachusetts
5 state building code regardless of whether the work being performed is new construction or
6 repair, renovation or alteration work.
