Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 19 of chapter 15A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 14 and 15, the words "Massachusetts
- 3 National Guard members" and inserting in place thereof the following words:- Massachusetts
- 4 residents serving in the National Guard or Armed Forces Reserve.
- 5 SECTION 2. Said section 19 of said chapter 15A, as so appearing, is hereby further
- 6 amended by striking out, in line 17, the words "Massachusetts National Guard members" and
- 7 inserting in place thereof the following words:- Massachusetts residents serving in the National
- 8 Guard or Armed Forces Reserve.
