An Act relative to municipal millennials.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after  
2 section 33B the following section:-

3 Section 33C. A city or town, that accepts this section in the manner provided in section 4  
4 of chapter 4, may permit licensees holding all alcoholic beverages or only wines and malt  
5 beverages to be served and drunk on the premises licenses, to sell the beverages, as the case may  
6 be, at a discounted price; provided, however, that the beverages are listed at a discounted price at  
7 least 3 week days between Sunday to Wednesday, inclusive.
