An Act to extend the time for the issuance of alcoholic beverage licenses in the city of Woburn.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Subsection (f) of section 1 of chapter 86 of the acts of 2020 is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the words “within 3 years after the effective date of this act” and  
3 inserting in place thereof the following words: “on or before May 29, 2026”.

4           SECTION 2. This act shall be effective upon its passage.
