An Act ensuring access to state IDs for low-income people.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 8 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after the words "age of 70." the following sentence:-
- 3 No fees associated with an application for a license shall be charged for a person at or

4 below 300 per cent of the federal poverty guidelines.

- 5 SECTION 2. Section 8E of said chapter is hereby amended by inserting after the words
- 6 "age of 70." the following sentence:-
- 7 No fees associated with an application for an identification card shall be charged for a
- 8 person at or below 300 per cent of the federal poverty guidelines.
