**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to equitable towing rates.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 6B of chapter 159B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 3, after the words “motor vehicles”, the
3 following words:- or any commercially registered vehicle not requiring a CDL license.

4 SECTION 2. Said section 6B of said chapter 159B, as so appearing, is hereby further
5 amended by inserting, in line 14, after the word “persons”, the following words:- or any
6 commercially registered vehicle not requiring a CDL license.
