## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to the study of transit arrival times.

**HOUSE** 

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other general or special laws to the contrary, there
- 2 shall be a commission to study the on time percentage of commuter rail trains in the
- 3 commonwealth. The commission shall consist of 2 members of the house of representatives, 1 of
- 4 whom shall be appointed by the house minority leader, 2 members of the senate, 1 of whom shall
- 5 be appointed by the senate minority leader, the commissioner of the Department of
- 6 Transportation or a designee, and 2 members to be appointed by the governor.
- 7 SECTION 2. The commission shall publish its findings and recommendations with the
- 8 Joint Committee on Transportation at a date not more than six months after the passage of this
- 9 bill.
- SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
