1 SECTION 1: Section 94 of chapter 32 of the general laws as appearing in the 2006 official
2 edition is hereby amended by inserting in line 8 after “correction” the following words:- “or a
3 county correctional facility”

4 SECTION 2: Section 94 of chapter 32 of the general laws as appearing in the 2006 official
5 edition is hereby amended in line 9 by striking out the words “the care, supervision or custody
6 of” and inserting in place thereof the following words:- “contact with”
