**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to the obstruction of public ways by railroad.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 151 of Chapter 160 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking, "not less than two hundred nor more than five hundred," and inserting in place there of
3 the follow, "not less than five thousand nor more than ten thousand".
