Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Group four of paragraph (g) of subdivision two of section three of chapter 32 of
2 the General Laws, as amended by section 52 of chapter 38 of the Acts of 1995, is hereby further
3 amended by inserting after the words "assistant district attorneys":— “investigators and attorneys
4 of the Committee for Public Counsel Services who have been employed in such capacity for ten
5 years or more.”
