**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act establishing a yearly audit of the Department of Transitional Assistance.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 12 of chapter 11 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after the third sentence the following sentence:- Notwithstanding
- 3 the foregoing, the department shall audit the department of transitional assistance at least once
- 4 every year.
