*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11 of chapter 131 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “retarded”, in line 38, the following:- No
- 3 fee shall be charged for a license issued under this paragraph to a disabled veteran with a 40
- 4 percent or greater service-connected disability.
