An Act fully funding the collective bargaining agreement in the Suffolk County sheriff department

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           A reserve in the amount of \$404,550 shall be created to fund costs associated with a  
2 collective bargaining agreement negotiated between the Suffolk County Sheriff's Department  
3 and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 93, Local 419,  
4 AFL-CIO; provided, that said reserve shall fund group legal benefits as described in the  
5 collective bargaining agreement covering the period from July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2008;  
6 provided, further, that the Sheriff of Suffolk County is authorized and directed to expend these  
7 funds for this benefit in accordance with the terms of the collective bargaining agreement listed  
8 herein.
