An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Sheila Santelli, an employee of the department of housing and community development.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the  
2 trial court of the commonwealth shall establish a sick leave bank for Sheila Santelli, an employee  
3 of The Department of Housing and Community Development. Any employee of said department  
4 may voluntarily contribute 1 or more of his/her sick, personal or vacation days to said sick leave  
5 bank for use by said Sheila Santelli. Whenever said Sheila Santelli terminates employment with  
6 said department or requests to dissolve said sick leave bank, the balance of the sick leave time  
7 shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank.
