An Act relative to the Sewer Rate Relief Fund.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 1. Section 2Z of Chapter 29 of the General Laws is amended by adding the
- 2 following sentence: No less than \$2,000,000 from the general fund be allocated to the Sewer
- 3 Rate Relief Fund with no less than \$200,000 allocated to the town of Tewksbury for sewer relief
- 4 purposes effective upon passage.
