#### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to compensating a family member as caretaker.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, a family
- 2 member may be the designated paid caretaker for a member of the family with a traumatic brain
- 3 injury received while in military service. The prerequisites for this designation by the
- 4 department of public health and any other department shall include, but not be limited to,
- 5 training and certification.
