An Act relative to court fees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 1 Section 3 of Chapter 90C of the general laws is hereby amended by adding at the end
- 2 of Paragraph (4) of Subsection (A) the following:
- 3 In the event the violator is found innocent of the infraction, the court fee of \$25 will be fully
- 4 refunded.
