The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act making August 31st overdose awareness day in the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Whereas, recognizing that addiction is a disease, Overdose Awareness Day aims to raise
2	awareness of overdose and reduce the stigma of drug-related death; and
3	Whereas, Overdose Awareness Day acknowledges the grief felt by families and friends
4	remembering those who have met with death or permanent injury as a result of drug overdose;
5	and
6	Whereas, globally, an estimated minimum of 190,900 premature deaths are caused by
7	drugs. The United States leads the world in drug overdose deaths, with opioids accounting for
8	the majority of drug-related deaths. Such deaths are avoidable in most cases; and
9	Whereas, this day provides an opportunity for people to mourn publicly for loved ones,
10	some for the first time, without feeling guilt or shame. It also sends a strong message to current
11	and former drug users that they are valued; and

- 12 Whereas, in recognition of Overdose Awareness Day, the House urges the citizens of this
- 13 great Commonwealth to educate themselves about this important issue.
- 14 Therefore: The Commonwealth of Massachusetts officially declares August 31st
- 15 Overdose Awareness Day and recognizes it as such.
