An Act increasing opportunities for clean peak energy storage.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 3 of Chapter 25A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by striking out the definition of “Qualified RPS resources” and inserting in  
3 place thereof the following definition:-

4           “Qualified RPS resource”, a renewable energy generating source, as defined in  
5 subsection (c) or in subsection (d) of section 11F that has: (i) installed a qualified energy storage  
6 system at its facility; (ii) has a contract with a qualified energy storage facility for a portion of its  
7 generation; or (iii) commenced commercial operation on or after January 1, 2019.
